All water for resale to Brave Water and Sewer Authority will be billed pursuant to the approved rate of \$8.67 per 1,000 gallons used per month.

DELAYED PAYMENT PENALTY

The above schedule is net. On all current accounts not paid in full when due, ten percent (10%) will be added to the net current amount unpaid. This delayed payment penalty is not interest and is to be collected only once for each bill where it is appropriate.

RECONNECTION FEE

\$20.00

To be charged whenever the supply of water is turned off for violations of rules, non-payment of bills, or fraudulent use of water.

ADMINISTRATIVE FEE

\$20.00

To be charged whenever the utility dispatches personnel to turn off the supply of water for non-payment of bills and the customer makes payment prior to actual disconnection.

FIRE HYDRANT SERVICE CHARGE

There shall be a charge of \$91.96 per hydrant per year.

PRIVATE FIRE PROTECTION

Where connections, hydrants, sprinklers, etc. on private property are maintained by the customer:

6 - inch service line with hydrants, sprinklers,	\$15.56 Monthly
and/or hose connections 8 - inch service line with hydrants, sprinklers,	\$33.15 Monthly
and/or hose connections 10- inch service line with hydrants, sprinklers,	\$59.61 Monthly
and/or hose connections 12- inch service line with hydrants, sprinklers,	\$96.29 Monthly
and/or hose connections	

TAP FEE

The following charge is to be made whenever the utility installs a new tap to serve an applicant:

A tap fee of \$150.00 will be charged to customers applying for service before construction is completed adjacent to the customers' premises in connection with a certificate proceeding before the Commission. This pre-construction tap fee will be invalid after the completion of construction adjacent to an applicant's premises that is associated with a certificate proceeding.

A tap fee of \$350.00 will be charged to all customers who apply for service outside of a certificate proceeding before the Commission for each new tap to the system.

(I) LEAK ADJUSTMENT

\$4.84 per 1,000 gallons is to be used when the bill reflects unusual consumption which can be attributed to eligible water leakage on the customer's side of the meter. This rate shall be applied to all such consumption above the customer's historical average usage.

RETURNED CHECK CHARGE

A service charge equal to the actual bank fee assessed to the District, not to exceed \$25.00, will be imposed upon any customer whose check for payment of charges is returned by his or her bank due to insufficient funds.

SECURITY DEPOSITS

Not to exceed two-twelfths (2/12) of the average annual usage of the applicant's specific class, or fifty dollars (\$50.00), whichever is greater. This fee may be changed by applicable statutory provisions.
